Examples: I have a cat. He is called Moritz. I have had him for more than 15 years.
I play the drums. I have been playing the drums for about 2 years.

Replace the words in the boardgame by personal events, dates, names, favorite things...

For example: Mr. Hois, May 2005, Thomas, skiing

Your classmates will then have to guess what these words mean and they will have to guess how long you have known the person, how long you have done something or how long you have had something.

Example: I think Mr. Hois is your favorite teacher. Am I right? You have known Mr. Hois for 3 years.

Example: I think you play the piano. You have been playing for 5 years.
