- **Jing:** Put your pictures into a powerpoint presentation. Open the presentation. Then record the presentation with [Jing](#) and read your text as you are recording.
- **Screencast-o-matic:** This new program works just like Jing. It is a bit more versatile and allows you to upload your finished video to the screencast-o-matic server or to youtube and/or download it to your computer. These options make [screencast-o-matic](#) one of the best options we have.
