For the teacher:

Aim: to practice the use the present perfect tense to express the notion of EXPERIENCE.

Materials: Print all the students' names on a table and cut into cards. Bring masking tape to stick the cards on the learners' backs.

Instructions:

Your teacher is going to stick the name of one of your classmates on your back.

Find out your "new identity" by asking your classmates questions concerning your previous experiences. Every question must start with:

Have I (ever) +verb....

e.g.: Have I ever been to India?

Have I ever failed a math test?

Tip: Think of clever questions that will rule out a whole group of students or specific individuals.

e.g.: Have I ever lived abroad?

Look around the classroom and think of specific things that some of your classmates have done:

Have I ever been kite-surfing?
