If you search in the undergrowth, turn to Page 6.

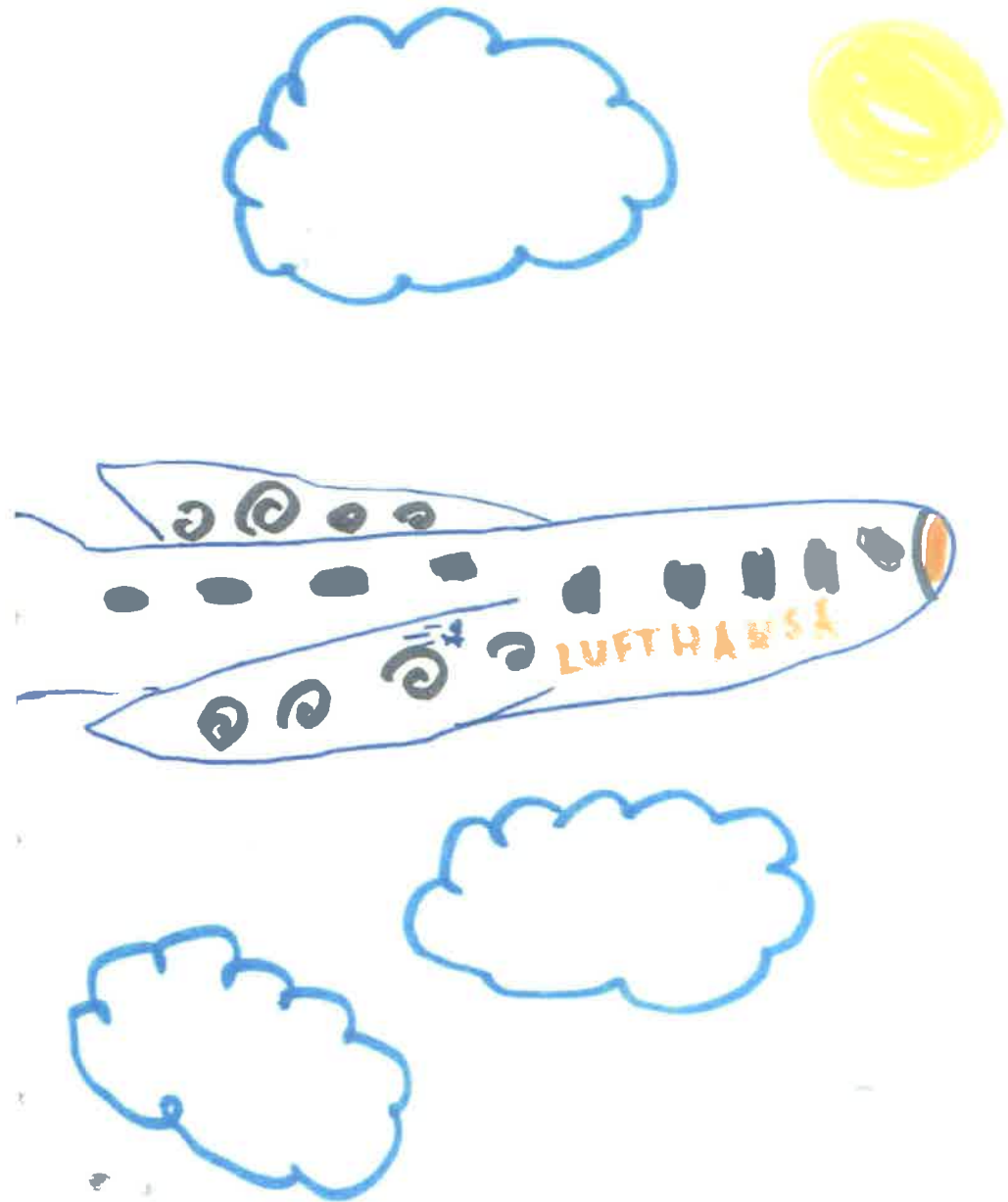


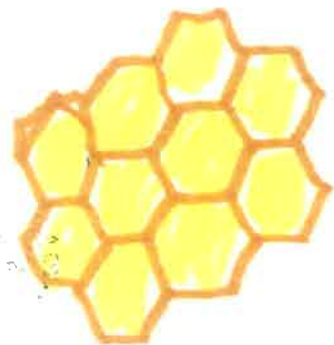

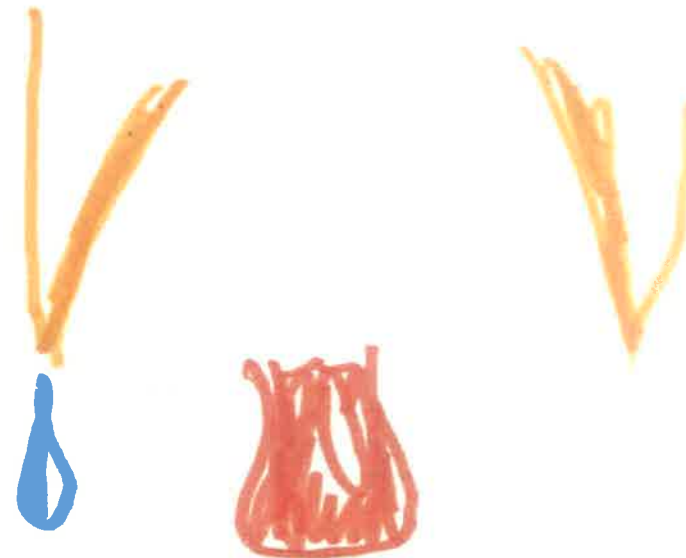




The whole hive is full of rich, golden honey! You begin to eat. You think: The tiger is dangerous, this hive is full of honey and very comfortable. What should you do?

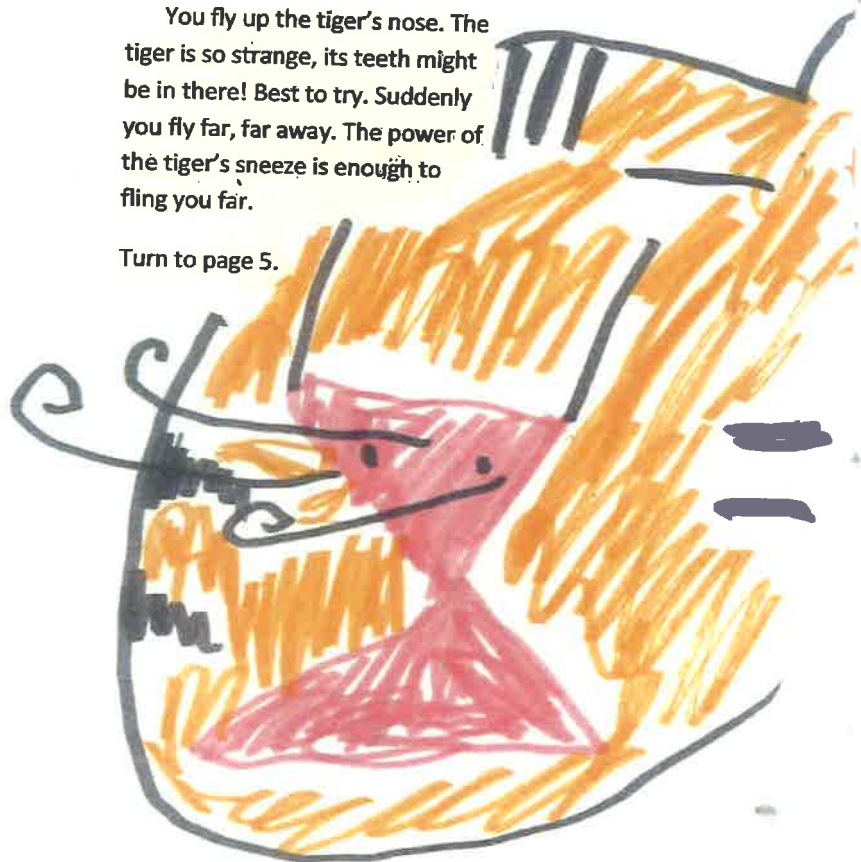
Turn to page 15.

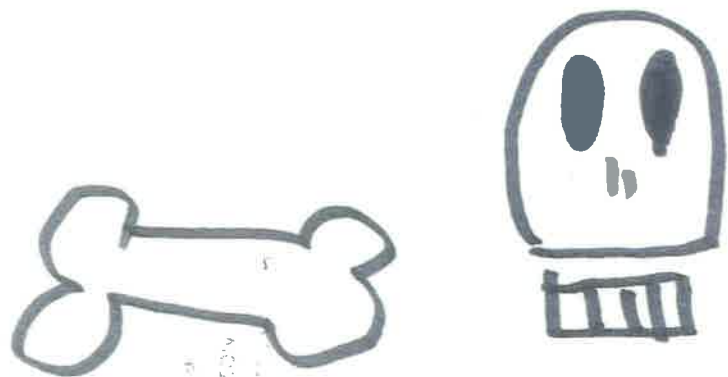

If you want to follow him, turn to Page 2 or 7.



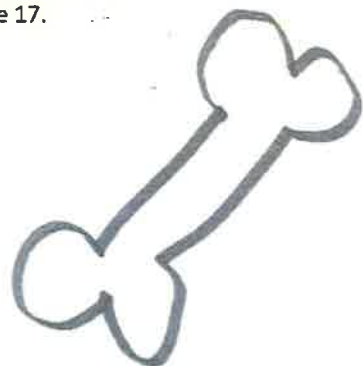




„Thank you so much for your help!”

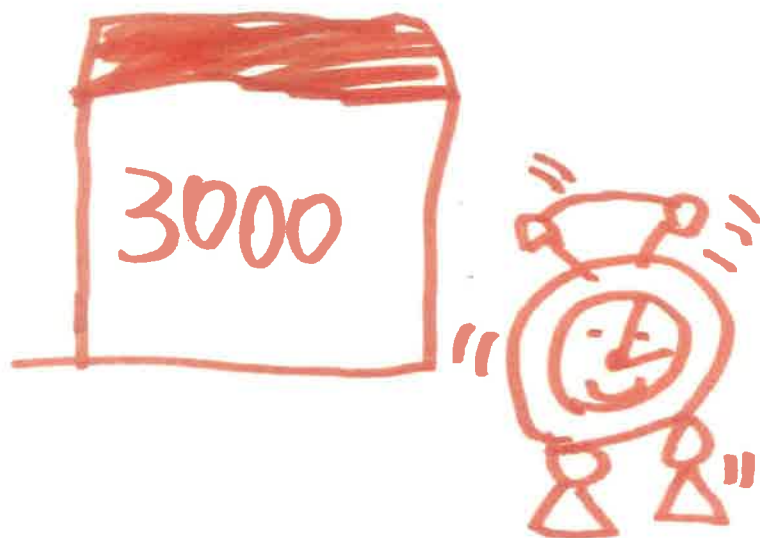

If you want to forget this plan, turn to Page 19.





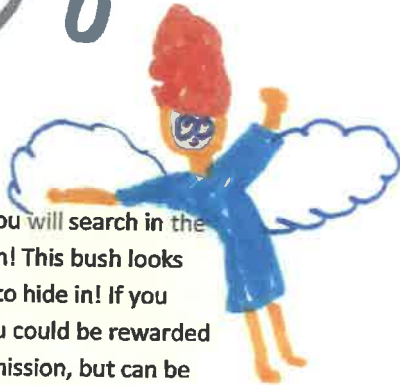
You decide to stay in the hive. You eat loads of honey, help the bees and after 3 000 years you die of diabetes.







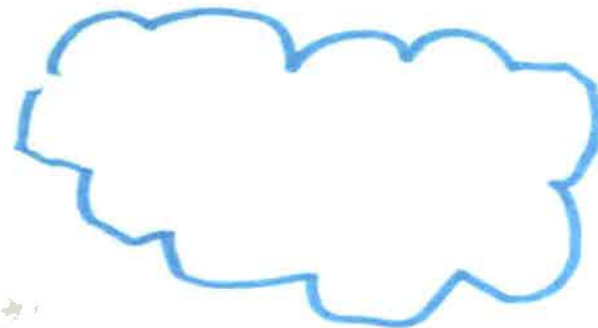
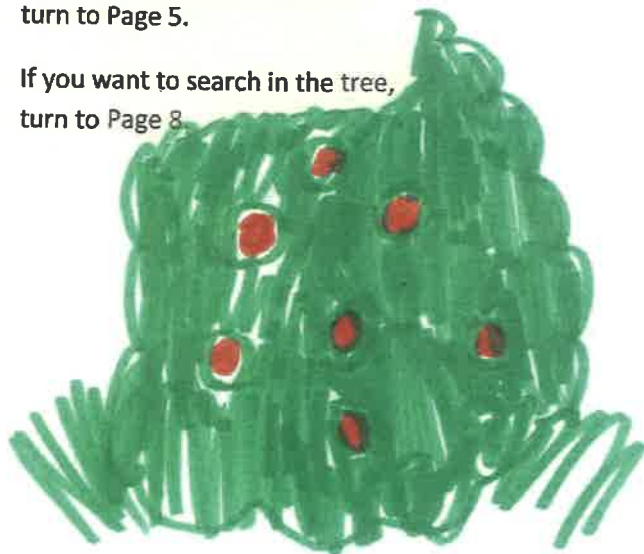

If you want to search in the bush, turn to Page 5.

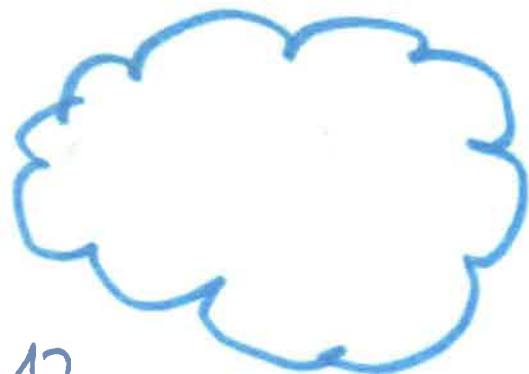
If you want to search in the tree, turn to Page 8.

Turn back to Page 1.

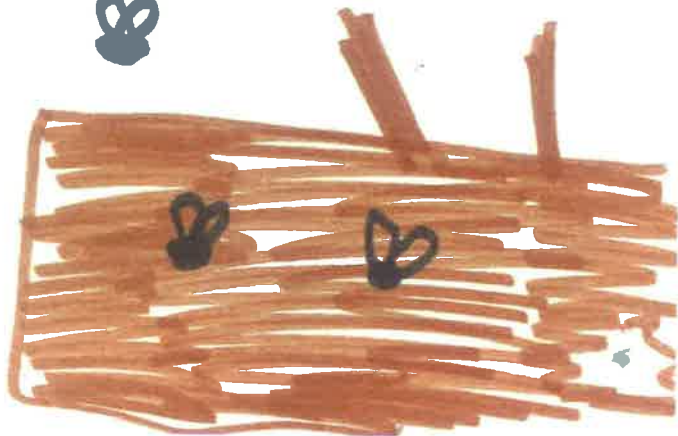


BZZZZZZ

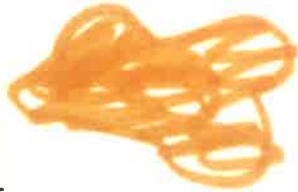
