Conferencing Tips

When you are conferencing with a classmate you need to remember that the writer has selected you as someone who can **help him or her with a piece of writing**. While writers want to hear about the positive features of their writing, they also want to hear your ideas about how they can improve their text.

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Read the text sample below and give feedback and advice to the writer. Read the text very critically and ask yourself: Do I really understand everything? Maybe some of the ideas are not expressed clearly enough to be understood. In your feedback point out

- what went well and what you like about the text
- where you have problems understanding the text
- whether the text is interesting for you and what could be done to make it more interesting
- mark any language errors you come across
- suggest stylistic improvements if necessary
